At the NABC Heritage Center there are 50+ academic papers from advanced degree programs that relate to the Cameroon mission of the North American Baptist churches. Some thirty are authored by missionaries, thirteen by African nationals with Baptist backgrounds and the remainder by others with an interest in the Cameroon mission. Several are about the North American Baptist Conference, the denomination that supported Cameroon missionaries.

Authors who are Cameroonian, Nigerian, or missionaries are indicated. Papers relating to the Mambilla area of Nigeria are included since that was a part of Cameroon prior to 1961 and served by North American Baptist missionaries.

Several of the papers are not physically in the Cameroon Collection and are noted as "(Note: See General Theses Collection)".
