

Cameroon Mission History in the Cameroon Collection at the North American Baptist Conference Heritage Center

Starting around the Mid-20th Century, missionaries, anthropologists, and others (Cameroonian and Western) with a deep interest in the spiritual and/or social situation in Cameroon have written academic papers including theses, dissertations, etc. in advanced degree programs.

In the NABC Heritage Center there are about 50 such academic papers. Thirty-one of these are by long-term or short-term missionaries, 13 by African nationals with Baptist backgrounds (as indicated in the last item in each entry), and the remainder by others with an interest in the Cameroon mission. The "Cameroon Collection Guide" at the NAB Heritage Center contains further notes about some of these papers.
