

*Mark Buchanan*

Mark is the rare author who writes wonderfully and communicates well in front of an audience, with theological depth driving both. He loves Jesus and the church. He is gifted in bringing biblical truth through the telling of biblical stories live. Mark is a professor of Pastoral Theology at Ambrose Seminary in Calgary and has written several books, including *Your Church is Too Safe*, which challenges the church to be a disruptive force to whoever opposes the Kingdom of God and a healing power to those who seek it.



*Kent Carlson*

After just a few minutes of listening to Kent, you will be embraced by his deep love for people and his desire for followers of Jesus to find deeper connections with Jesus. With an infectious laugh, Kent will move you to understand deep spiritual formation with a fresh biblical approach. The NAB VP of Leadership Formation and the pastor emeritus of Oak Hills Church in Folsom, California, Kent seeks to encourage pastors and leaders in their own spiritual formation. His co-authored book, *Renovation of the Church*, has stimulated churches to rethink the role of the church and pastoral ministry.



*Don Davis*

A man of humble roots, Don's passion for the church and the gospel will engage your heart and soul. As the founder and director of The Urban Ministry Institute, he has been involved in urban ministry and missions since 1975. He has authored a number of books, curricula, and study materials designed to equip, empower, and release biblical leaders to serve the Church of Jesus among the most vulnerable and unreached urban communities and display Kingdom transformation where they live and minister.



*Stephanie Fast*

Hearing Stephanie tell the story of her journey toward faith and transformation will inspire you. As she shares her compelling journey of being abandoned by her mother as a young child and rescued from the streets of Korea by a World Vision nurse, your heart will be shaped with praise for a God of transformation and a new compassion for the plight of orphans around the world. Stephanie's moving story will remind you that God can reshape every heart and soul, no matter how deep the wounds.



### *Dan Hamil*

As the NAB executive director, Dan's warm and caring spirit will bring you into a comfortable space where he will help you explore the hard questions of what it means to be the church in a post-Christian era. With a long history in the NAB and a love for the NAB family, he ushers leaders into a future of gospel engagement with an ever-changing world.

Barry combines the deep insights of a seminary professor and the meaningful words of a teaching pastor to move hearers to embrace biblical incarnational living. 
