

Domestic Chaplaincy Certification

To qualify for endorsement as a domestic NAB chaplain to serve in a hospital, care facility, or a similar institution, applicants must meet the following requirements:

- Active membership in good standing in an NAB church
- Ordination
- Licensing
- Endorsement of the Regional Minister

Application for endorsement shall be made by written communication to the endorsing officer of the NAB (email is sufficient). The request shall include evidence of fulfillment of the above requirements, including a copy of the ordination certificate.

Upon verification of the above, a letter will be written to the Board of Chaplaincy Certification, Inc. endorsing the candidate as an NAB chaplain.
